The **Green Flag** is dropped at the starting line when the race is on. During the race it signifies that the course is clear. The **Yellow Flag** is to warn Drivers to use caution during the Display of which Drivers shall not change race positions. The **Red Flag** is used to denote that the race has been stopped and the **Black Flag** is to order a car off the track. The **Chequered Flag** indicates the end of a race.
