This important Classic Meeting of the Stock Car Racing calendar promises to be every bit as exciting, if not more so, than last year's debut With a very attractive prize money schedule, the entry list is filled with top drivers from all parts of the Country, anxious to make a bid for the Title Races in both Junior and Senior categories and in the knowledge that this unique "Mountain" Circuit is one of the most interesting and certainly the toughest in the Country.

Heading the list is World Champion Ellis Ford, the Birmingham driver, who is leading on the National Points Table and can, up to present be declared "King" of Cadwell Stock Car Racing. His Ford Special (No 3) carries the gold roof denoting World Championship holder. Ellis will do well to forge his car and keep it, in front in the 40 Lap Race, as starting in front of him will be many Star grades (Red Top) cars driven by the best known pilots in "stox", such as ex-World Champions Fred Mitchell (Car No. 38 with winking lights) and Doug Wardropper (5), also ever popular Chick Woodroffe (1), Alan Wardropper (245)—son of Doug; Ron Rogers, top in Championship points, Willie Harrison (2) who makes a welcome return after a long lapse; George Ansell (375) third, behind Harrison, in Championship points; Willie Wanklyn (304) and Mick O'Hara (372). These last two being in the Blue grade, but always well up where the fighting is going on.

The Juniors, equally keen to wrest the "Race of the Year" title in their own grade, are a formidable set, with Doug Wardropper, Chick Woodroffe and Don Evans (37) having double entries. Ian Durham (658) the Banbury "Flyer" and Steve Bateman (676) from the same town are also in Star grade and well up in the Formula 2 Grading List. Dick Sworder (720) recently "demoted" to Blue grade will make strong efforts to be restored in the Star grade. Bob Reeve (0) has a long FI experience and is familiar with this circuit.

Keep an eye also on Bill Barker (381) who recently won 2 World Championship round events at Harringay; and Frank Wooster (738) whose blue top Fiat chased winner Chick Woodroffe home in two races here on July 3rd.

These Meetings have proved to be equally as thrilling in wet weather as in dry, such conditions requiring totally different techniques and everyone today can look forward to a really "humdinger" afternoon's sport. The sparks—and straw bales—are going to fly today!

We wish all the Competitors good driving and best of luck's knowing that this coupled with great skill and a fast motor, will be the necessary ingredients for the fortunate one who receives the first prize laurels and £100 cheque.


