
Williams Grove Speedway, in Mechanicsburg, PA


The banked oval dirt track is just ½ mile long.

Jerry Mayer "over-ran" the rear wheel of Johnny Kay, and the subsequent ride looked like this, in a sequence of 9 photographs.























## Notice the reactions of the spectators:
