## GREAT DAY

This is another Great Day of Cadwell, and, in fact East Midlands, Stock Car Racing—with a bigger-than-ever entry of Britain's Tops in both Seniors and Juniors striving for "Race of the Year" Title (not forgetting the £100 and trophy first prize in the Senior Final).

### Possible Winners

Taking the Juniors first—after 25 laps of this demanding circuit, we could well see a third "Race of the Year" victory going to Bill Barker (709) or a second victory to Steve Bateman (676) who was first in 1968 and second last year. Current World Champion, Ron Innocent (712) will be another favourite—he had engine trouble last year. Most of the Juniors however, have an equal chance so far as circuit knowledge is concerned, as this is the only meeting each year at Cadwell for the Juniors

The Senior race has another long list of potential winners, including 1967 and 1968 winner and 1968 World Champion, Tony Neal (100) who is still top of his form. Chick Woodroffe (1) now Star grade, is to follow up his comparative easy successes at Cadwell earlier meetings this year, racing with white and yellow roofs. George Ansell (375), another Cadwell favourite closely followed Tony Neal home in last year's "Race of the Year". Ian Durham (311) has moved from his high grade in Juniors, to Seniors and quickly gained Star grade recognition. He could well be in one of the top places after the 40 gruelling laps.

### The Balloon

By popular demand, and subject to weather, Cadwell Park patrons will be treated to the sight of the huge 4-man Hot Air Balloon for the second time in this County in over 70 years. "Jester" was launched here at the August 17th races.

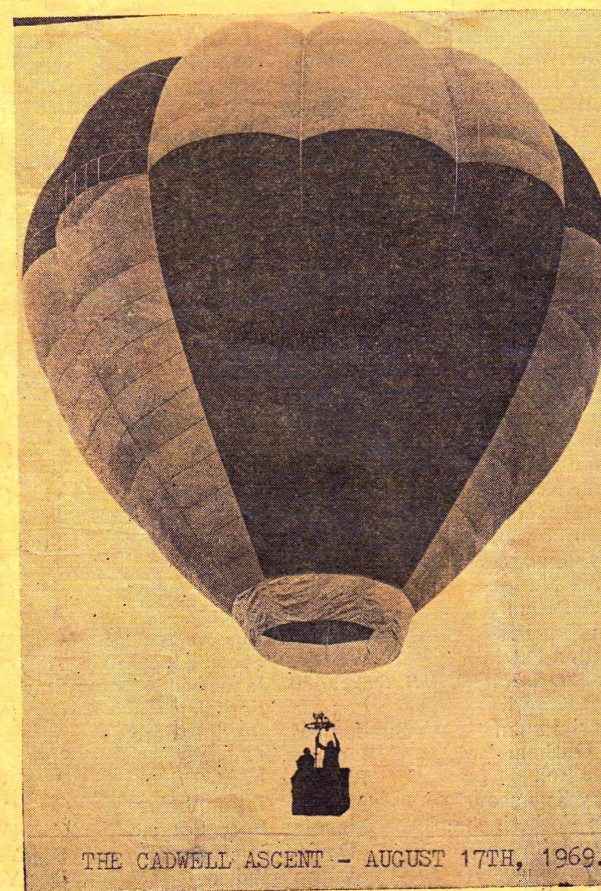

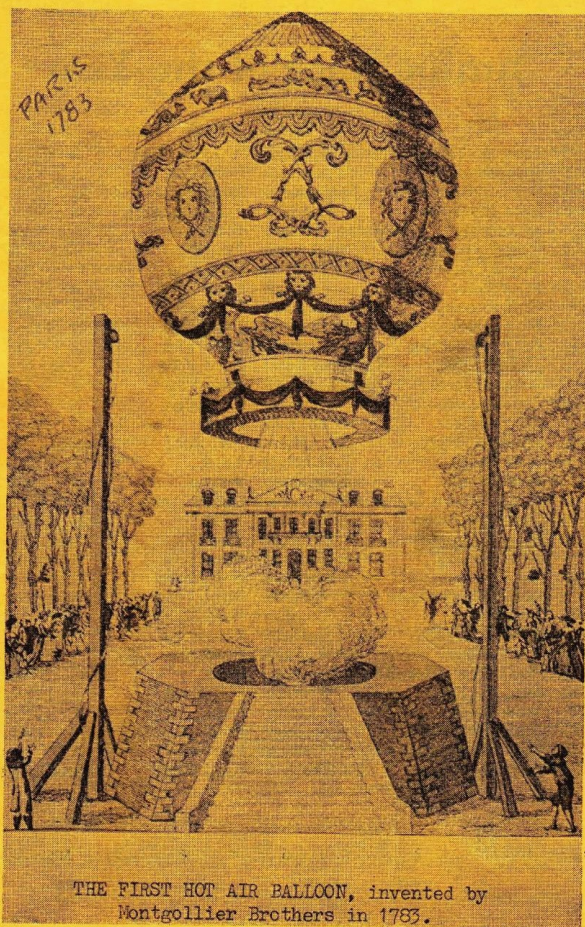
